



**CBS 34 Course duration: 5 days**

This five day course is based on the original structure set by the International Register of Certificated Auditors (IRCA) in the UK.

The course is registered with the Southern African Auditor and Training Certification Association SAATCA. The first two days focuses on absolute detail of the ISO 14001.

Note: No pre-requisite courses are required as the SAATCA criteria is fully complied with.

The **Objective** of this course is designed to provide the delegate with a detailed exposition of SABS ISO 14001:2004 and details of environmental legislation and the effects of waste and pollution, the phases of environmental systems assessments, planning performance and follow-up and an understanding of corrective action and its implications

The third and fourth days focus on ISO 19011 Guidelines for management system auditing. One of the most powerful tools in management techniques if constructively utilised by competent personnel is the outcome of an effective audit which can add value to executives to drive continuous improvement in the organisation, It is imperative that the auditor understands that the output of an audit must add value to the organisation, that the auditing process is not perceived as a criticism when non-conformities are revealed rather than an opportunity to improve..

The **Objective** of this course is designed to provide the delegate with a detailed exposition of SABS ISO 14001:2004 and details of environmental legislation and the effects of waste and pollution, the phases of environmental systems assessments, planning performance and follow-up and an understanding of corrective action and its implications

The course will give as much simulation to an actual audit as is practically possible in a classroom situation and includes extensive syndicate exercises and group work.
